ANTI RAGGING MEETING REPORT

An anti-ragging awareness meeting was conducted for the I B.P Th students to educate them about the ill effects of ragging and to create a safe and supportive academic environment. The meeting was held on **14/1/2026** at **First BPTH Classroom**.

The meeting began with a welcome address by Dr Samruddhi who emphasized the importance of maintaining discipline, mutual respect, and harmony within the campus. The students were informed that ragging is a serious offense and is strictly prohibited as per UGC and institutional norms.

During the session, Dr Mrunali Patel explained the definition of ragging, its various forms (physical, verbal, psychological, and cyber), and the severe legal consequences associated with it. Students were made aware of the Anti-Ragging Act, punishments involved, and the zero-tolerance policy followed by the institution.

The anti-ragging committee members were introduced, and the procedure for reporting ragging incidents was clearly explained. Students were encouraged to report any incidents without fear, as confidentiality and protection would be ensured. The availability of helpline numbers and online complaint portals was also shared.

The session concluded with an interactive discussion, during which students actively participated and clarified their doubts. An anti-ragging pledge was administered to all I B.P Th students, affirming their commitment to uphold ethical behavior and refrain from ragging in any form.

The meeting successfully created awareness among the students and reinforced the institution's commitment to providing a ragging-free campus
